Lassen Land and Trails Trust, a 24 year old land trust whose mission is to conserve natural areas and agricultural landscapes and to promote and enhance a public trail system in Lassen County, California, is recruiting a full-time Lands Manager to play a leadership role in the coordination of the Trust's conservation and trails strategy, to implement acquisitions and conservation easements, and carry out the Trust's stewardship responsibilities on all properties, including enforcement. The Lands Manager will work closely with the Executive Director to develop and meet program goals. The Lands Manager must have the skills and experience to work closely with landowners, funding agencies and partners. Included in the responsibilities are resource management, execution of baseline documentation, drafting of conservation easements and deed documents, and writing grant applications and other project reports. The Lands Manager will also work with the Trust's team on outreach and education activities that are related to the conservation elements of the Trust's mission.

Familiarity with the Land Trust Alliance's Standards & Policies, best management practices for conservation, as well as comfort with GIS ArcView and MicroSoft Office Suite are required. A valid driver's license is required, as well.

This is a full-time position based in Susanville, California, the county seat for Lassen County in northeastern California where the Sierra Cascade meets the Modoc Plateau and the Great Basin. Compensation is based on experience. Health benefits are also included in the compensation package.
